

Diploma of Business Communication


This intensive full time diploma program is for ESL students who want to prepare themselves to be excellent business communicators in English. This program focuses practically on being a proficient communicator in business environment.

In addition to learning strategies and specific skills for all sections of the test, students will additionally focus on necessary and general grammar, speaking, listening, writing, and reading skills.






Night School
